half an hour late.

had tea, Munde went back.
& Willie & I ~~go~~ went down
to Bog hall Dock & saw
the tide rise, Papa arrived
at 5.15 being 1/2 hour late
had tea. Papa & I ~~went~~ & Willie
went on to the pier came back
by Ryther pass. & along the
cliff house had supper
& turned in.

set out @ 8.30. and.

with Papa

I un walked to the Light house
over the fields ^{& back by the sea} saw a pair
of Cormorants, had a wade
in the water got dressed.

sat down in a pool of water
Papa putting his feet into one.

saw 3 or 4 whale's jaws stuck
in the ground & forming arches.
got home at 12.30. & had dinner

~~walked a mile~~ went to meet
my Uncle ^{with Papa} doing so a mile
beyond Rustwarp. came home
had tea. saw Uncle off. & walked

along the pier with Papa. As the
cliff & saw the promenade
began to rain so walked back
home. Willie has got a gathered
heel, he bathed it in hot water
which he's bin using at tea time.

reduced the inflammation -

set out with Papa &

Mon, Went passed the Church
along the cliff. & came down
passed Saltwick Nab. & made
a sketch of the east Cliff beyond
Saltwick. Saw thousands of
small holes in the sand. &
vent & poked little things
like maggots came jumping
out which we found to be
young shrimps. I had another
wade & then came home @ 1.30
I had dinner, did not go out
in afternoon because it rained
had tea. I went out to fish
I caught an eel about 1 ft long
Came in I went to post. & along
the pier stood to watch an
auctioneer. I came home by
the cliff had supper & went
to bed @ 10. O'clock.

TUES

Tues.

Willie Papa & I set out by train @ 10.10. to Leighton P.A. & I got a sketch & then we came back @ 12.30. & had dinner. Then we went out ~~and~~ fishing. I caught nothing but Willie caught a young cod fish & a repulsive thing with a very big head & some spikes along its back. we then came in & had tea, ~~and~~ then went out to fish a while again without success. it began to rain so we came in & had supper & went to bed. It rained very heavily the greater part of the night—

Wed It rained but cleared
up about 11 so we had
a walk on to the pier.

I came in in time for
dinner after which it
rained again but we
went out about 2.30.

I met with Mr Holroyd
his son & a friend -
who were just going out
fishing so Willie & I jumped
in & we went ~~out~~ about

2 miles out & then cast our
anchors & threw in our

lines Willie caught the first

whiting Mr Holroyd then
caught 1 Gurnard & his son

1 plaice & I caught 1 Gurnard
& 1 plaice Mr Holroyd's friend

caught nothing [6]

so that we had.

2 Whiting 2 Gurnard 2 plaice
making a total of 6.

It began to thunders so we
drew up the anchor &
put up the sail when we
got about 1 mile in it
began to rain in torrents
so that we were pretty wet.
When we got in Mr Holroyd
gave us the other two fish.
We got home & had tea
after which we changed
our clothes. we were idle
till we got supper. after
which we went to bed &.

THURS

This morning I & Papa -
walked to Sandoe and I saw
Sneaton Castle we both
took a sketch & came home
over the cliffs in $\frac{3}{4}$ of an hour
& had dinner eating the
fish which we caught yesterday.
We did not go out this
afternoon but when we had
finished tea we walked to
Rushwarp. where we saw an
aviary consisting of an Owl.
thrush. hawk & several smaller
birds. we came back & stopped
in the house a while & at 9
o'clock he had a walk
to the station & back after
which we came in &
went to bed.

FT 2

Before breakfast I went
to the station to fetch the
papers. it rained very hard
~~this morning so we could~~
~~not get out~~ we put our
macks. on & got out a bit
& when we got back Uncle
was here & he had brought
some potatoes cabbage & card.
Mushrooms. Uncle & Papa
went away to Goathland
at half past three & Papa
is going to stop till tomorrow
morning. We had tea &
went out with Alf & Harold
over the bridge. & we came
back by the West cliff.
& skinned the mushrooms.
had supper & then went
to bed. This is the worst we have
yet had: very heavy rain in the
afternoon -

After breakfast I went down
to the station & took a sketch
of the old town while Willie
& Grandma had a walk on
to the pier we came in & had
~~lunch~~ ^{dinner} & when we had finished
we saw Papa coming down
the hill from Rinswarp. & when
he came in he said he had
missed the train from Sleight
we went into Badergate to order
provisions & then we to meet
Mr. Frouwe. & had tea. after
which we went to the saloon
& heard the concert & Willie
& I came home (leaving Mr. Frouwe
& Papa to smoke their pipes.)
I had supper and when they
came in we went to bed
this is the finest day we have had

After breakfast Papa & Mr Drew
went to the station to meet
Uncle & two Mr Jones & Mr Reid
when they were going to
Robin Hood's Bay. —

We went on to the Sands —
& came back & had dinner

in the afternoon we
did not go out although
it was beautifully fine
but stopped in & read.
We then had tea &
Papa & Mr Frewer came
in at about 6 O'clock.

~~We went~~ Papa Mr Frewer
& I went on to the cliff
while Willie & Miss Harri-
ette went to the Congress
Hall & heard the mission.
This day was quite as fine
as day. []

We had breakfast &
then went to the station
& ~~went~~ to Southland ^{at 9.15} to spend
the day. We arrived &
amused ourselves with
playing at quoits till
dinner time after which
Papa & Uncle had
several games. We had
tea & then Mr Tremack
left to go to Leech ^{by the 6.33} & we
again we left Southland
station at ~~five past~~ 8.5
& arrived at Whiting
at 8.40. When we had
supper

It rained very hard all day I could not except at night when I was obliged to go out to set some bread

Wed.

It rained quite as heavy today as it did yesterday but still Papper & I went to Exton by train where we both got two sketches. each then we walked through Archiff woods up to Beggars bridge & back again then we walked to Grosmont & saw huddles jumping then we got in the train & came home.

Thurs.

This day was quite as
bad as either Tues- or Wed
but we went on to the pier
& sands in the morning -
~~for~~ It was much too wet
to go out this afternoon

Fri.

In the morning Papa Willie
& I went to sand dunes. It
it was blowing a gale
for they had the S.
Cone hoisted - & the dry
sand was blown up
with great force as we
were going it was in our
faces. I was blown
back two yards as soon
as we had made four
to it was very slow work

we came back by
the cliffs. I had dinner
in the afternoon we went
to the exhibition & came in
I had tea - went to the
exhibition again I went to bed.

Sat.

This morning we went
to the exhibition I saw
about 40 of Mr. Wehrle's
pictures we had dinner
& left Whitby for Leeds.
at 2 o'clock arriving at
our destination about
5.30. we came up to Hall
in a cab & got safely home
thus ended our
holiday in
WHITBY.

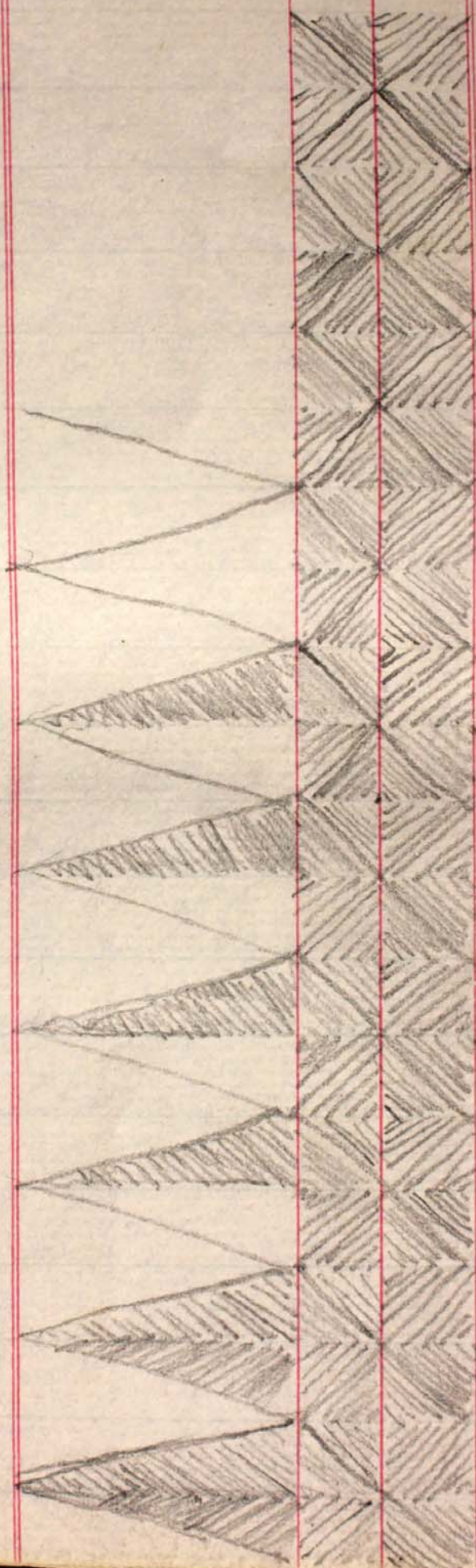
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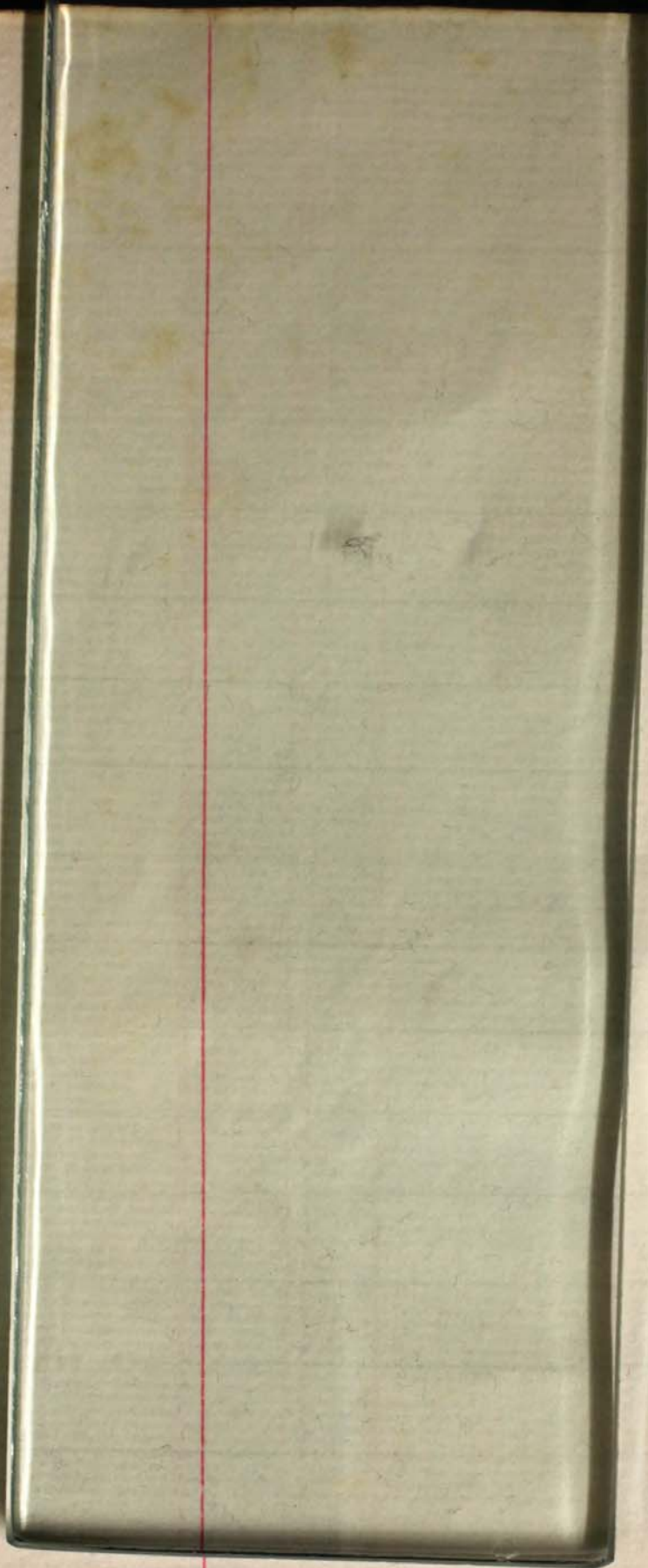

Put the sugar in a pan with
7. ~~pt~~^{wine} bottles full of water.
let it just boil & set it aside
to cook. When milk. add
the tartaric acid the lemon

quite firm) stir well into
liquid bottle for use
1 wine glass full to a tumbler
2 parts filled with water
& stir in a little carbond.

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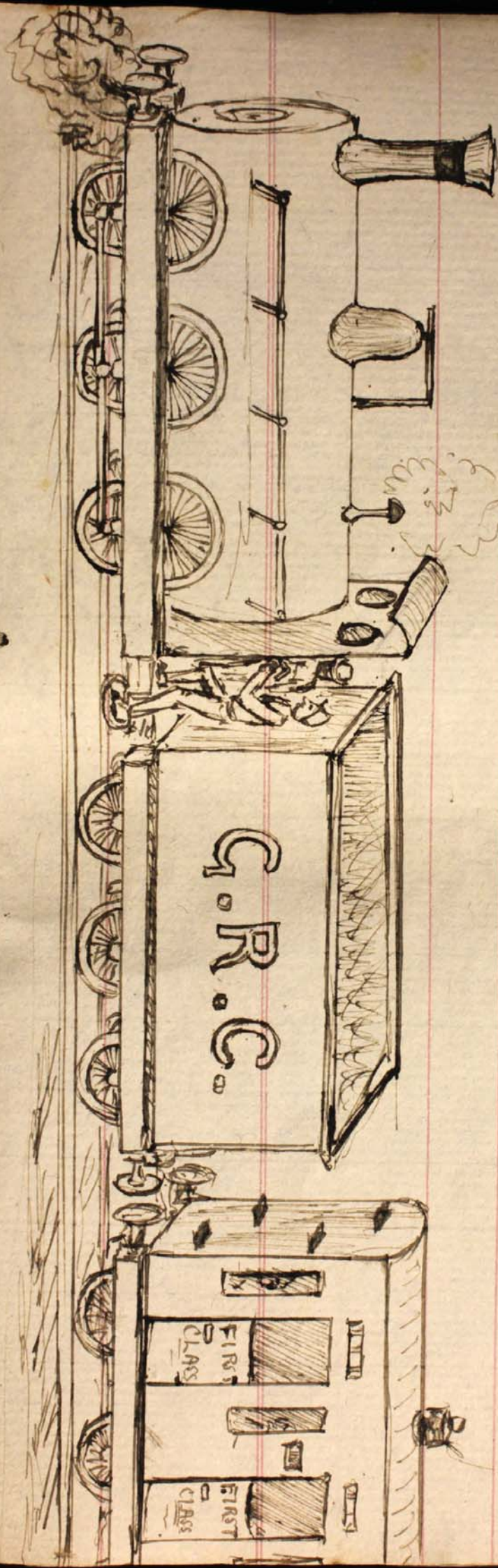
